We offer employment in the largest research institute of the Polish Academy of Sciences. The Nencki Institute is active in the fields of neurophysiology, molecular and cellular neurobiology, biochemistry, protein chemistry, cell biology, neuropsychology, bioinformatics and neuroinformatics. The candidate's scientific interests should fall within the research fields of the Nencki Institute.

The initial contract in this position will be for 5 years, with a possible extension after a positive evaluation of the candidate's achievements. We offer furnished laboratory space adjusted to the individual needs of the successful candidate, as well as access to the Institute's shared equipment and facilities. The selected individual will be entitled to take on three team members.

Qualified researchers interested in applying for the position should submit the following documents:

- letter of intent

- list of publications
- short proposal of research plans (no more than 3 pages)
- reprints of three selected experimental papers
- contact information to at least 3 referees
