



## EVO system

All employees have access to the EVO portal, where they can apply for holidays, on-demand leave, remote work or business trip. Holidays applications cannot be submitted retrospectively. If the employee agreed with his supervisor, but did not write out the application in time, he is obliged to submit a leave application in paper form, signed by the supervisor.

Through the EVO system, employees also have access to their personal data, salary and benefits, they can print payroll and PIT-11 necessary for annual tax settlement.

### **Private medical care**

### **ZUS** health insurance

ZUS (The Social Insurance Institution) is a state institution that carries out tasks related to social insurance in Poland. All employees, regardless of their country of origin, employed under an employment contract, are required to be insured with ZUS by their employer. PhD students from Poland and other EU countries are also covered by insurance through their employer. PhD students from non-EU countries must insure themselves with ZUS and pay monthly contributions.
